SOUTH COST FISHING CLUB& ASSOCIATION RULES GOVERNING APPLICATIONS FOR SOUTH COAST FISH RECORDS

- 1. Claimant shall be a current financial member of a club affiliated with the SCFCA
- 2. All applications to be in the hands of the SCFCA Recorder within 50 days of capture
- The Australian Anglers Association Records Authority are to be the official reference for recognition of species
- Records will be determines at SCFCA Delegates meetings. The record certificate shall be signed by the President and honorary Recorder and where possible, presented to the applicants club or club delegate.
- All fish accepted by the AAARA and conform to the regulations and requirements of the NSW Fisheries Department will be eligible for record claim.
- Weights, accepted to the nearest 10 grams, must exclude all foreign matter (sand etc), fish to be weighed whole. No allowance shall be made for loss of weight of fish cleaned or headed prior to weighing
- 7. Mutilated fish will not be recognised
- 8. Claimant must hook and land, boat or beach his own fish; but may receive such assistance by gaffing, gilling or use of a landing net; but does not include handling of rod, reel or line prior to the fish being landed, boated or beached
- Fish caught by any legal means except netting, trapping or deliberate jagging are eligible for record claims
- Fish submitted for recognition as a South Coast record must be caught in the waters of NSW including the coastal waters of NSW and ACT waters
- 11. All applications to be made on SCFCA official claim form
- 12. The fish must be weighed on government certified scales
- 13. The application fee for records is \$2.00
