

Point Score Rules for OBHFC Monthly Competitions

The Monthly competitions recognise fish numbers, species and weight.

Anglers earn points based on the number of fish, the number of species and the weight of the catch.

- 1) One point is allocated for each fish weighed.
- 2) Ten points are allocated for each kilogram weight.
- 3) Ten points are allocated for each eligible species caught from the Species Comp List.

E.g. an angler who weighs in 8 different species earns an extra 80 points with the possibility to gain a maximum of 200pts if they can catch all 20 species.

By giving the species a points rating it can become more advantageous for an angler to target several fish species instead of pursuing just one. This will make the competition even more challenging pushing members to fish out of their comfort zone while producing a wider variety of species and less bag outs at weigh-ins.

EXAMPLE: Angler A weighs in a bag of 20 fish comprising of 5 different eligible species for a total bag weight of 9kg.

9kg x 10 = 90 pts
20 fish x 1 = 20 pts
5 species x 10 = 50 pts
Total = 160 pts
