OCEAN BEACH HOTEL FISHING CLUB COMPETITION RULES

(Amended 01.08.2022)

- 1) Fishing competitions will generally be held on the second clear weekend of each month. All dates are advertised in the newsletter and on the notice board in the pub.
- 2) Competitions commence midnight Friday, with lines up 12 noon Sunday. Anglers may fish anywhere in NSW and/ or ACT.
- a) The Deep Sea competition will be suspended if the Bureau of Meteorology issues a **Gale Warning**. The Deep Sea Competition will only resume once the warning has been lifted.
- 3) Bag Limits for competitions are set out in the The Club Competition Species List.
 - a) NSW State Fisheries **fish sizes** will apply.
 - b) A maximum of 20 fish may be weighed at monthly competitions.
- 4) Where there is **no NSW legal length** for a species, a minimum length of 30cm will apply except for Groper, which needs to be 45 cm long.
- 5) Eligible species which are not on the <u>Club Listed Species List</u>, are limited to one (1) specie. A maximum total of one (1) **other eligible fish** can be weighed at monthly comps.
- 6) All fish presented for weighing must be gilled, gutted and roed.
- a) Fish may be weighed whole during competition and have a 20% point deduction. This rule is to help anglers keep a large fish for moulding or where appropriate storage is difficult.
- 7) Any angler attempting to weigh fish under the minimum length will be disqualified.
- 8) Any angler attempting to weigh fish in excess of the bag limit will have the excess fish removed and be penalised 50% of total points.
- 9) The weigh in will be held at the hotel at 1 pm. Competitors must have their catch in the weigh in area before 1 pm.
- 10) Fish weighed for the Yearly Board or club records may be weighed whole and recorded in the weigh master's receipt book in the club cupboard in the pub.
- 11) Fish weighed for records must be weighed on certified or certificated scales.
- a) A time limit of 30 days, from date of capture, will apply for all receipts for the yearly board and club records. These receipts may be mailed, texted, emailed or hand delivered. It is the responsibility of the angler to have the receipt in the hands of the Weighmaster or representative within the 30 day period.
- 12) The weigh master's decision is final.
